The doors will open to the public at 1:45 p.m.** The Board may vote to go into executive session on any agenda item pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.03(A)(2) for discussion or consideration of records exempt by law from public inspection, including the receipt and discussion of information or testimony that is specifically required to be maintained as confidential by state or federal law as related to any agenda item. The Board may vote to go into executive session on any agenda item pursuant to A.R.S. 38- 431.03(A)(3) for legal advice with the District’s Attorney as related to any agenda item. **Executive Sessions are confidential pursuant to Arizona Statute.** The Board may change the order of the agenda items. The Board may also decline to consider any agenda item. One or more Board Members may attend the meeting through technological devices. (A.R.S. 38-431)

Call to the Public - A public body may make an open call to the public during a public meeting, subject to reasonable time, place and manner restrictions, to allow individuals to address the public body on any issue within the jurisdiction of the public body. Any staff member may speak as a member of the public. Nothing said is to be taken as the official stance of the Palominas Fire District. At the conclusion of an open call to the public, individual members of the public body may respond to criticism made by those who have addressed the public body, may ask staff to review a matter or may ask that a matter be put on a future agenda. However, members of the public body shall not discuss or take legal action on matters raised during an open call to the public unless the matters are properly notified for discussion and legal action.

Montgomery - The Board might vote to go into executive [closed] session, pursuant to A.R.S. 38-431.03(A)(3) & (4), for legal advice from the Board’s attorney.
